

## PREAMBLE FOR TBARC TUESDAY NIGHT NET

Good evening, my name is  *[Your Name]* ,  *[Your Call]* , and I will be your Net Control for this Tuesday Night Thunderbird Amateur Radio Club Net. This is a directed net, which meets each Tuesday night at 7:30 pm local time. The net is open to all radio amateurs and covers subjects of general interest to amateur radio. You may check in on either the 2 meter repeater at 146.700, or the 70 Cm repeater at 446.150.

This net is sponsored by the Thunderbird Amateur Radio Club, which meets on the third Thursday of each month in Room 29 of the Snell Building on the campus of Thunderbird School of Global Management located near 59<sup>th</sup> Ave and W. Greenway Road in Glendale. Check the club website @ [www.w7tbc.org](http://www.w7tbc.org) for directions, information about the club, our programs, and upcoming events.

Before the Net, is there any emergency traffic? This is  *[Your Call]*  Net Control. **(Pause for any emergency traffic...handle as required)**

Do we have any short timers who would like to simply check-in and out of the net? If so please give your call sign using phonetics and state your name slowly please. **(Pause for Short Timers...When finished, recognize each check-in, list names on a log sheet, and move on to the regular check-ins)**

At this time I will start regular check-in procedure. After check-ins are complete I will go to the top of the list and ask each participant for comments, conversation, or help in solving a problem. This is a net that encourages hams helping hams. So, if you have something to share with a fellow ham, this is the net for you.

I will now begin regular check-ins. Please give your call sign using phonetics and say your name slowly please! **(List each check-in by call and name in your log. At the end of 6 to 8 check-ins or a lull in check-ins, recognize each in turn and ask for clarification of call or name if necessary, then proceed with more check-ins.)**

**(When it appears that most have checked in, proceed with the round table in the order of their checking in. After the first round is complete, ask for late check-ins.)**

Are there any others who would like to join the net at this time, or anyone whose call sign and name I didn't mention? If so, come now please. **(Record the additional information and start at top of list and go through all check-ins a second time.)**

**(After the second round, ask if anyone wants to make additional comments or would like ask a question. When everyone who wants to talk has done so, bring the net to a close.....)**

That concludes tonight's Thunderbird Amateur Radio Club Tuesday Night Net. We invite you to join us every Tuesday Night on these repeaters starting at 7:30 pm. And, please don't forget the next club meeting on  *[October 15<sup>th</sup>]*  and the Saturday morning breakfast at Denney's on W. Bell Road starting at 7:30am on  *[November 7<sup>th</sup>]* .
